Katherine S. Conway-Turner, Ph.D.

Katherine S. Conway-Turner, Ph.D., began her tenure as the ninth president of Buffalo State College on August 3, 2014. As president of SUNY's largest and only comprehensive college located in an urban setting, Dr. Conway-Turner oversees and manages more than 1,500 faculty, staff, and administrators who provide more than 75 undergraduate and 60 graduate academic degree programs each year.

President Conway-Turner's vision for Buffalo State to become "Buffalo's College" through engagement, excellence, and social responsibility has been embraced and is paying off in dividends for both the college and the community. The college's commitment to service has been recognized nationally under President Conway-Turner's leadership. In 2016, Buffalo State was among five colleges and universities from across the country chosen to share in the Washington Center's annual Higher Education Civic Engagement Awards. The college has also earned the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching's Community Engagement Classification under President Conway-Turner, as well as accolades from the President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll.

President Conway-Turner earned her Ph.D. and M.A. in social psychology, and her B.A. in microbiology, all from the University of Kansas.

Before coming to Buffalo State, President Conway-Turner was provost and vice president for academic affairs at Hood College in Frederick, Maryland, from July 2010 until July 2014. From 2004 to 2009, she was provost and vice president for academic affairs at SUNY Geneseo. She was the dean of the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences at Georgia Southern University and associate dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at the University of Delaware, where she also served as director of the women's studies program and graduate program coordinator. She was an American Council on Education (ACE) fellow at the College of New Jersey, and she has held teaching positions at Santa Clara University and California State University, Long Beach.

President Conway-Turner is married to Dr. Alvin L. Turner, a psychologist licensed in New York and Delaware, who is engaged in the independent practice of psychotherapy, supervision, training, and forensic psychological services. They have three adult daughters, and in 2016 they became first-time grandparents.

BACCALAUREATE AND GRADUATE SCHOOL COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS



Letitia A. James

Letitia “Tish” James is the 67th attorney general for the State of New York. An experienced attorney and public servant with decades of legal work and a long record of accomplishments, she is the first woman of color to hold statewide office in New York and the first woman to be elected attorney general in New York State.

In 2013, Ms. James was elected public advocate for the City of New York and became the first woman of color to hold city-wide office. As public advocate, she served as a watchdog over New York City government agencies and as an advocate for the city’s most vulnerable communities. She transformed the public advocate’s office into a formidable engine for change.

Her office handled over 32,000 constituent complaints and passed more legislation than all previous public advocates combined, including a groundbreaking law that banned questions about salary history from the employment process to address the pervasive gender wage gap. Ms. James successfully took on the gun industry by pushing New York City’s largest pension fund to divest from gun and ammunition retailers. She fought on behalf of children and families on issues including children in foster care, children with disabilities, and tenant protection. New Yorkers overwhelmingly elected Ms. James to a second term as public advocate in November 2017.

Before serving as public advocate, Ms. James represented the 35th Council District in Brooklyn in the New York City Council for 10 years. As a council member, she helped pass the Safe Housing Act, legislation that forced landlords to improve living conditions for tenants in New York City’s worst buildings. She helped uncover the corruption behind the Office of Payroll Administration’s CityTime contract, a scheme that cost New York City over \$600 million. She also pushed through a revolutionary recycling package that included expanding plastic recycling as well as a new clothing and textile recycling program, and she increased access to recycling in public spaces.

Before her election to the City Council, Ms. James served as head of the Brooklyn Regional Office of the New York State Attorney General’s Office, where she resolved hundreds of consumer complaints and investigated predatory lenders who preyed on first-time homebuyers. She assisted the Civil Rights Bureau in its investigation of the NYPD’s stop-and-frisk policy and cracked down on firms engaged in deceptive business practices, including violations of human rights, environmental laws, and scams targeting immigrants.

Ms. James began her career as a public defender at the Legal Aid Society. A proud Brooklynite, she is a graduate of Lehman College and Howard University School of Law.

Darryl W. Dennard, Class of 1981

Darryl Dennard is an award-winning broadcast journalist whose news anchoring and producing talents are familiar to radio listeners and television viewers everywhere. With more than three decades of experience, Mr. Dennard has interviewed such powerful influencers as President Barack Obama, Oprah Winfrey, and Michael Jackson. He is the host and producer of *Chicago Speaks*, Chicagoland's top-rated radio program, airing live on Sundays from 6:00 to 8:00 a.m. He can also be heard weekly on iHeartMedia's WVAZ-FM, WGCI-FM, and WGRB-AM's community affairs programming.

His producing and on-camera skills most recently reached tens of millions of homes via the *Black Enterprise Report* (BER) on WGN cable and satellite feeds. Before joining BER, he was the host and producer of the *Minority Business Report*, the nation's longest-running television program devoted to minority business. His news and marketing expertise puts him in great demand as a moderator and public speaker.

Mr. Dennard received his degree in broadcast journalism from Buffalo State College and began his career as a reporter at WGRZ-TV, the NBC affiliate in Buffalo, New York. He then went on to serve as cohost of the nationally syndicated *Ebony/Jet Showcase*. During a stint at Johnson Publishing Company, he was also associate editor of *Ebony Man* magazine, after which

he was hired as the morning news anchor for *Good Day Chicago* on WFLD-TV. Following his time at WFLD, he went on to host a myriad of programs including *Know Your Heritage*, the NAACP ACT-SO Awards, and BET's *Screen Scene*. For more than five years, Mr. Dennard was the executive director of the Radio and Television Broadcasting and Theatre departments at Kennedy-King College, one of the City Colleges of Chicago.

Currently, he is the owner of Double D Productions Inc., a full-service audio and video production company specializing in documentary, corporate, and commercial video production. He produced and directed the award-winning documentary *Heading West*, detailing the history of African Americans on Chicago's West Side, which aired locally on PBS. With more than two decades of experience, Double D Productions has established a unique niche among its competitors as a highly effective, cost-conscious communicator of ideas from concept to completion.

Mr. Dennard is a member of the Men's Leadership Team, a moderator for the Young Brothers for Christ Youth Ministry, and a Sunday school teacher at the Apostolic Church of God in Chicago. Professionally, he held memberships with the 100 Black Men of Chicago, the National Alliance of Market Developers, and the Black Public Relations Society, and he is a former board member of the Cosmopolitan Chamber of Commerce.

Eric J. Greenberg, Class of 1978

Eric Greenberg, director of United Nations relations and strategic partnerships at the Simon Wiesenthal Center, is an international and national award-winning journalist, communications and outreach director, and interfaith leader. With professional expertise in media relations, investigative journalism, and humanitarian issues—including environmental and children’s health, disaster preparedness, refugee aid, multifaith dialogue, and cooperation—he writes and edits thought-provoking pieces, manages social media, and deftly handles crisis communications for the Wiesenthal Center, one of the largest international Jewish human rights organizations in the world.

Rabbi Greenberg’s diverse work experiences have allowed him to educate, guide, inspire, and influence fellow students, colleagues, faculty, and leaders on a wide variety of levels. With an expansive reach, he has melded his investigative journalism background with groundbreaking advisory work to help improve communication through interfaith dialogue and cooperation among a diverse group of populations.

A graduate of Buffalo State’s journalism program, he honed his craft as news editor of the student newspaper, the *Record*, and learned from the seasoned reporters at both the *Courier-Express*

and the *Buffalo News*, sharing his voice to reach the community on timely issues that reflected the zeitgeist of the 1980s. He studied in the graduate program at the University of Maryland, College Park, and later went on to serve as the director of interfaith affairs for the Anti-Defamation League and chief of staff of Columbia University’s National Center for Disaster Preparedness.

He has been featured in such publications as *U.S. News & World Report*, the *Village Voice*, *Huffington Post*, and the *New York Times* and has garnered many awards, including the Society of Professional Journalists’ Sigma Delta Chi Award for Public Service in Newspaper Journalism, the Investigative Reporters & Editors Award, and the National Press Foundation’s Thomas Stokes Award, as well as induction to the Buffalo State Communication Department’s Hall of Fame.

Rabbi Greenberg has excelled in areas that mirror the mission and purpose of the State University of New York in the fields of public affairs, humanities and the arts, scholarship and education, and social services. With his commitment to change and grassroots efforts, he demonstrates that one voice can make a difference and that there are many paths to improving communication and fostering connectedness.

SUNY HONORARY DOCTOR OF FINE ARTS



Joseph Saddler

Joseph “Grandmaster Flash” Saddler, Barbadian American DJ and Rock and Roll Hall of Famer, is one of the originators of the worldwide musical cultural phenomenon of hip-hop. Noted for his pioneering use of the turntable as a musical instrument, he helped elevate the status of DJ to the masterful, artistic position it holds today. His career has extended from New York City in the early 1970s to all corners of the globe, including performances at the Super Bowl and for Queen Elizabeth II of Great Britain.

Grandmaster Flash began his career in the Bronx with neighborhood block parties that essentially created what would become a global sensation. He invented the Quick Mix Theory, which included techniques such as the double-back, back-door, back-spin, and phasing, allowing a DJ to make music by placing his fingertips on the record and gauging its revolutions to create his own beat. Flash’s template grew to include cutting, which in turn spawned scratching, transforming, and the Clock Theory, among others, laying the groundwork for modern DJ artists today.

By the end of the 70s, Flash had started another trend that became his international hallmark: the magnetic allure that led break dancers and emcees to follow him to various parties to rap and dance over his seamless beats. Before long, he started

his own group, Grandmaster Flash and the Furious Five, whose reputation grew as the group blended their lyrics with Flash’s acrobatic performances, spinning and cutting vinyl with fingers, toes, elbows—any object at hand. Grandmaster Flash and the Furious Five’s single “The Message” went multiplatinum.

In 2007, Grandmaster Flash and the Furious Five became the first hip-hop group inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. Flash has received many additional awards, including the Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award, the Recording Industry Association of America’s Lifetime Achievement Award, VH1 Hip Hop Honors, the BET Icon Award, Bill Gates’s Vanguard Award, the international Polar Music Prize, the BET Jam Master Jay Tribute Award, the Global Spin Awards Lifetime Achievement Award, and the Rock Walk Award. He is included in the Bronx Walk of Fame.

Other accomplishments include appearances in the film *Wild Style* and the TV show *Yo! MTV Raps*; coining the phrase “Beat Box”; and serving as a film consultant and music director for the Netflix film *The Get Down*. Future projects include the A&E documentary *The Secret Origins of Hip Hop*, a Grandmaster Flash action figure, and adventures in the Metaverse. He continues to tour the world in festivals, clubs, and venues and now has his sights on new craze-dance music, which has been added to his legendary repertoire.

Todd W. Brason, '85

Todd Brason, former chairman and founder of Willcare home health care, is well known for his leadership and generous service to the community. As chief executive officer and chairman of the board of Willcare, he led the company from a single agency in Western New York to a regional home-care provider with 15 branches in New York, Connecticut, and Ohio.

Mr. Brason has served as chair of the New York State Association of Health Care Providers Inc. (HCP) and was an executive board member of the American Association for Home Care. He is actively involved in community events in the Buffalo region as a former board member of the Buffalo Zoo, former chairman of the Greater Buffalo Chapter of the American Red

Cross, and former chairman of the Erie County Medical Center Lifeline Foundation. He received HCP's Richard Z. Steinhaus Award in recognition of his outstanding contributions to the home care community.

A talented executive, he also serves as chief strategy officer of TITUS Industrial Group Inc., providing global wastewater industry solutions.

A graduate of Buffalo State College's business administration program, he served as a member of the Buffalo State College Foundation board from 1998 to 2014 and as a member of the Buffalo State College Council from 2014 to 2021. His long and laudable service to Western New York reveals a commitment and dedication to the community and a better future for all.

Gary M. Brost

Gary Brost, chairman and CEO of Strategic Investments & Holdings Inc., started his career in the financial industry as an accountant. He founded Strategic Investments & Holdings in 1983, after serving in numerous positions of management at a major bank. Since its inception, Strategic Investments has made nearly 100 acquisitions while investing more than a quarter-billion dollars of equity capital.

Mr. Brost is an active and engaged philanthropist who has demonstrated a deep commitment to the community. He serves on the boards of directors of several businesses, including Microcision LLC and Merchants Mutual Insurance Company. He is a former board member and past chair of the YMCA's Camp Weona and a former board member of the Buffalo Niagara Partnership and of Gateway-Longview, a local nonprofit child and family services organization. He currently serves on the board of directors of the Buffalo Club and in various volunteer capacities at his undergraduate alma mater, Allegheny College.

When he joined the Burchfield Penney Art Center Board of Trustees in 2001, Mr. Brost embraced the idea of a new museum. As chairman of the board from 2004 to 2006, he spearheaded the effort, spending hundreds of hours raising money, advocating with elected officials, and working with the college to construct the first freestanding museum to be built in Buffalo in more than 100 years.

Mr. Brost has provided tremendous service to the college as a member of the Buffalo State College Foundation board of directors from 2003 to 2012 and as a member of the Buffalo State College Council from 2012 until 2016. His many business contacts have been invaluable in securing new members for the foundation board.

He holds an M.B.A. from the University at Buffalo and is a graduate of Harvard Business School's Program for Management Development.

The President's Medal is the highest honor the college awards to its graduating students. It recognizes excellence and distinction in scholarship, service to the college and community, and overall achievement.

BACCALAUREATE STUDENT ADDRESS PRESIDENT'S MEDAL FOR OUTSTANDING UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT



Nicholas M. Stanford

Nicholas Stanford has earned a bachelor of music in music education and a bachelor of arts in philosophy with honors, attaining a 3.98 GPA while participating in the Muriel A. Howard Honors Program.

Intellectually curious and passionate about learning, Mr. Stanford combines sophisticated critical thinking with an impressive work ethic. He has conducted unique research on the intersection of music and philosophy. His Undergraduate Summer Research Fellowship focused on how people respond to music and whether their emotional reactions are influenced by cognitive objects unrelated to the music. He later successfully defended his philosophy honors thesis on the topic of music and emotions and was lauded for his ability to explain complicated musical concepts. ACADEMIC TRADITIONS

ACADEMIC PROCESSIONAL AND RECESSIONAL

The academic processional begins with the entrance of the seating marshals, who lead the degree candidates to their seats. Faculty marchers follow, escorted to their places by the head marshal. The mace bearer then leads the platform party, which includes the dignitaries, honorees, and college administration, to the stage.

At the conclusion of the ceremony, the recessional order is reversed: the last to have entered the arena are the first to recess, in accordance with the ceremony's ecclesiastical origins. The mace bearer leads the platform party, headed by the college president, at a quicker and more celebratory pace than in the processional. The platform party is followed by the faculty marchers and, finally, the graduates, while guests witness the pageantry to its close.

THE MACE AND MEDALLION

By tradition, seals of office and tools of authority have been incorporated in the ceremonies that invest individuals with the responsibilities and power of official leadership. Today purely symbolic, these objects once effected control themselves, the mace having been originally an iron club capable of breaking armor.

About the middle of the thirteenth century, the mace was adopted for civic purposes. Much earlier, seals, from which the college medallion was derived, constituted the official signatures of heads of church and state. Today, the academic seal, representing the office of the college president, and the mace, standing for order and authority, have become part of the pageantry of symbolism involved in formal academic ceremonies.

For Buffalo State, both mace and medallion are enhanced by their being the design and work of faculty members. The gold medallion was designed by the late Earl W. Wolfgruber, a member of the Design Department faculty for 20 years. A gift of the Class of 1968, it was first used that year for the inauguration of President E. K. Fretwell Jr. and has been worn on official college occasions since. A neck piece was added in 1987, designed and crafted by Stephen F. Saracino, professor of design.

The 1968 inauguration was also the first occasion for the use of the rosewood and silver mace, designed and built by Douglas E. Sigler, at that time an assistant professor of design. The flaring silver flanges that circle the crown of the mace carry the engraved names of each president of the college. Incorporated in the total design are abstract concepts of flame, dove, and hands, used by the college to signify learning and aspiration. All formal academic processions are led by a mace bearer with this staff of authority in hand.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE

Academic attire—cap, gown, and hood—is higher education's link with its long and illustrious past. Like judicial dress, it originated in the twelfth century with the medieval clergy, whose ecclesiastical dress probably derived, in turn, from civilian attire at an earlier age. Medieval scholars were almost all clergymen, and the earliest illustrations available show gowns that somewhat resemble cassocks. Universities of the period were primarily education guilds, the term "bachelor" denoting an apprentice, "master" a full member of the guild, and "doctor" one who had attained the highest degree of learning in a particular field.

In the United States, academic attire began to be used extensively at the end of the nineteenth century. It has given America a beautiful and impressive method of signifying academic honors.

The bachelor's gown is black and worn closed, distinguished by its long, pointed sleeves; the master's gown is designed to be worn open and has long sleeves with square base and arc cut; the doctor's gown, worn open or closed, has velvet panels down the front and three bars on the round, full sleeve. The color of the velvet may signify the field of study.

The hood is the most distinguishing feature of academic attire. Its colors indicate the degree of the wearer and the institution attended. The bachelor's and the master's hoods are similar in design, but the bachelor's is 3 feet long while the master's is 3½ feet long. The colors of the silk lining exposed in the center of the hood are those of the institution conferring the degree, for example, blue and gold for the State University of New York. The edging of the hood indicates the academic discipline.

Since the hood no longer serves as a head covering, the mortarboard, which originated in English universities, is worn. A long tassel of black or of a color appropriate to the degree is fastened in the middle of the top of the cap. The doctor's cap may have a gold tassel. Recently, soft velvet tams have become popular for holders of advanced degrees.

Academic attire serves two purposes: it gives a sense of dignity and tradition to the ceremony, and it links those who wear it—students, faculty, and professionals—to all the men and women who have sought learning over the past centuries.

ACADEMIC TRADITIONS

GRADUATE HOODING AND VESTING CEREMONY

Buffalo State master's degree recipients are individually recognized by the ceremonial placement of their degree-appropriate hoods, called hooding, during the Commencement ceremony. Hooding assistants from the Graduate School assist the Graduate School dean and designated Graduate School members, representing each student's academic department, in the hooding ceremony. Certificate of advanced study (C.A.S.) recipients are vested with black-and-orange stoles, while graduate certificate recipients receive a white and orange cord.

STUDENT HONORS ACHIEVEMENT STUDENT ORGANIZATION AFFILIATIONS

The Gold Honors Cord

Graduates wearing gold cords at Commencement have achieved the distinction of graduating with academic honors. An honors citation is given to bachelor's students who have maintained a minimum 3.50 grade point average for all work completed at Buffalo State. Graduates who have completed a minimum of 60 credit hours at Buffalo State with an average of 3.80 to 4.00 are designated summa cum laude, 3.65 to 3.79 magna cum laude, and 3.50 to 3.64 cum laude.

The Gold Tassel

Graduates wearing gold tassels on their mortarboards have completed the Buffalo State Muriel A. Howard Honors Program or the Dean's Honors Program. Qualified students enter the programs as freshmen from high school, sophomores already attending Buffalo State, and when transferring from community colleges. Many honors program students receive academic scholarships, with funds provided by private donations and administered by the Buffalo State College Foundation.

Military Honors Cord

The red, white, and blue cord is used nationally to recognize honorably discharged U.S. veteran students, current students serving in the U.S. military (active duty, National Guard, Reserves), and Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) students commissioned upon graduation. Military-affiliated faculty and staff processors may also wear this cord.

Honor Society Cords

Students who are inducted members of national honor societies affiliated with Buffalo State are eligible to wear the appropriate honors cords designating their disciplines and honor societies.

Student Organization Regalia

Student members of campus professional and cultural organizations are eligible to wear the stoles representing their groups.

International

Students with international affiliations may wear stoles in accordance with their cultural traditions.
